Additional Charges

- All students must wear the Westlake Girls uniform to attend classes. Short-term students can wear their own school uniform.
- * If you are studying NCEA Level 1–3, there is a government-set fee of \$383.30 per year. You will receive an invoice once your courses are confirmed.
- * Top academic students may be invited to sit Scholarship exams. These cost \$102.20 per subject (set by the government).
- There is a \$50 fee if you ask us to send your school records. Extra copies cost \$10 each.
- Some courses or sports may have extra costs (e.g. equipment or activity fees). We will let you know if this applies to you. Items marked with * are provided by external companies, not the school. Prices may change. We will tell students as soon as new prices are available.
- In group visits, students may share a homestay if agreed.
