APPLICATION PROCESS

THE FIRST STEP

Before you start your application, make sure you have scanned copies of the following documents ready:

- Current Passport
- Portrait Photo
- Last two years school report (English translation)
- Vaccination certificate (if available, with English translation)
- Insurance certificate (if available, with English translation). All international students require travel & medical insurance while studying in New Zealand. This can be organised by WGHS.
- Online interview for long-term students or by request.

Please note: WGHS reserves the right to contact previous schools attended by the applicant.

THE SECOND STEP - WE ASSESS YOUR APPLICATION

If your application is successful, we will email the following documents:

- Offer of place
- Invoice with payment details

THE THIRD STEP - PAYMENT OF SCHOOL FEES

Once full school fees have been received by WGHS, we will email you the following documents which you will need to include in your Student Visa application:

- Receipt for fees paid
- A further copy of the Offer of Place

THE FOURTH STEP - WHAT NEXT?

You will need to apply for your Student Visa which you must have before you come to New Zealand. See www.immigration.co.nz or you can contact your nearest New Zealand Embassy or High Commission.

THE FIFTH STEP - NEARLY THERE!

Now you can book your flights, but please don't forget to let us know your flight arrival details so that we can arrange for you to be met and welcomed to Auckland airport!
